



Drowning is the second leading cause of accident-related deaths among children 1-14 years old, and the leading cause for children ages 1-4. Residential swimming pools account for 60-90% of drowning of children aged 0-4 years. Half of these occur at the child's own home and a third at the home of a friend, neighbor or relative.

### Keep your kids safe this summer as you head for the water by following these safety guidelines:

- Never leave children alone in or near the pool, even for a moment. A child can drown in the time it takes you to answer the phone.
- Stay within an arm's length of your child and watch them carefully. Young children don't splash, struggle or make noise when in danger in the
- water, and often quickly drown in silence. You cannot properly supervise children in water if you are reading, talking on the phone or drinking alcohol.
- ➤ Do not use flotation devices such as floaties, inflatable rings, etc... They give you a false sense of security, but they can slip off or deflate easily.

- Remove all toys from the pool after use so children aren't tempted to reach for them.
- Don't allow children to eat or chew gum while in the water. Both are choking hazards during water activities.
- Don't swim alone, or allow your children to do so. Even good swimmers can be injured or become fatiqued.
- Designate one adult as a "water watcher" when anyone is in the water. When your child attends swimming events, make sure there is proper adult supervision.
- Keep rescue equipment and a telephone near the pool.
- Anyone watching young children around a pool should learn CPR.
- Enroll your children in swimming lessons. Even very young babies can start learning the basics of water safety.

# Quick Pool Safety Checklist

- ✓ Is your pool surrounded by a climb proof fence?
- ✓ Are the gates self-closing and self-latching?
- ✓ Is the latching mechanism out of reach of children?
- Are all exit doors and windows leading from the house to the pool kept locked and secured?
- ✓ Is the rescue equipment kept near the pool?
- If you have a pool cover, is it properly installed? Never use a pool with its pool cover partially in place.
- ✓ Are steps and ladders leading to an above ground pool secured, locked or removed when the pool is not in use?
- Does the hot tub or spa have a solid locking cover and is the cover in place and locked when the spa is not in use?
